Road closures on and around Northumberland Avenue on Sunday 24 September

We are writing to let you know that Northumberland Avenue and a number of roads around Westminster will be closed to vehicles from 08:00 until 14:00 on Sunday 24 September as part of the Vitality London 10,000 running event.

Road closures will operate to allow a traffic-free route for the participants from the Start Line on The Mall, through Westminster and the City of London and back to the Finish Line on Spur Road, in front of Buckingham Palace.

A map of the affected area is shown on the reverse of this letter and highlights some of the roads that will be closed on Sunday 24 September, including Northumberland Avenue, Aldwych, Strand and Whitehall. Full information is available at vitalitylondon10000.co.uk/the-events/road-closures

Deliveries

If you need to make or receive deliveries between 08:00 and 14:00 on Sunday 24 September, you will need to drop off and/or collect the delivery at a designated drop-off point near the corner of Northumberland Avenue and Great Scotland Yard.

Stewards will be present to facilitate access for you from the junction of Victoria Embankment and Northumberland Avenue. See the map over the page.
