Vitality London 10,000 course map


Road closures will be in operation in central London on Friday 22, Saturday 23 and Sunday 24 September 2023 as part of the Vitality Westminster Mile and the Vitality London 10,000. The closures will affect the City of Westminster, City of London and the London Borough of Camden.

On Saturday 23 September the Vitality Westminster Mile, a series of family-friendly fun runs, will take place on closed roads around St James's Park. The map on the back page of this leaflet shows which roads will be closed.

Friday 22 to Sunday 24 September

The following roads will be closed from 06:00 on Friday 22 September until 22:00 on Sunday 24 September:

The Mall, Malborough Road, Spur Road, Link Road, Constitution Hill, Horse Guards Road and Birdcage Walk.

Saturday 23 September

The Vitality Westminster Mile will begin at 10:00 on Saturday 23 September on The Mall.

Buckingham Gate and Buckingham Palace Road (from the junction of Bressenden Place) will close from 08:00 until 16:00.

Buckingham Gate, Great George Street, Whitehall, Trafalgar Square, Northumberland Avenue, Great Scotland Yard, Duncannon Street, Strand, Aldwych, Chancery Lane, Holborn, Holborn Viaduct, Newgate Street, King Edward Street, St Martin's Le Grand, Cheapside,

King Street, Gresham Street, Lothbury, Princes Street, Threadneedle Street, Queen Victoria Street, Cannon Street, New Change, and New Fetter Lane.

Safe and secure

Emergency vehicles will be treated as a priority in the usual way throughout the entire weekend. Police officers and stewards will be present during both events to help answer your queries, ensuring a safe and secure weekend.





Sunday 24 September

The Vitality London 10,000 will start at 10:00 on Sunday 24 September on The Mall. The following roads will close from 08:00 until 14:00:

City of London resident access routes

On Sunday 24 September residents encircled by the road closures on Chancery Lane, Holborn, and New Fetter Lane can exit the area at the following crossing points:

- Southampton Buildings to Holborn eastbound carriageway
- Furnival Street to Brooke Street or Holborn eastbound carriageway

Residents on St Andrew Street, Shoe Lane and surrounding areas will be able to enter and exit via Shoe Lane and Charterhouse Street.

Residents of Little Britain and Bartholomew Close can enter and exit the area via Rotunda (Museum of London).

Access will be facilitated by stewards only when it is safe to do so. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
