Greenwich ...

The 44th annual edition of the London Marathon takes place on Sunday 21 April 2024 and will require road closures and parking restrictions in your area.

Tens of thousands of participants will take on the 26.2-mile course, which starts at Blackheath and passes through Charlton, Woolwich and Greenwich town centre, before leaving the borough towards Deptford.

This leaflet provides specific access details for Greenwich area residents.

Road closures

So the 2024 TCS London Marathon can go ahead safely, several roads in Greenwich will

be closed from 07:00 to 15:00 on Sunday 21 April 2024. If you need to leave the area in a vehicle on Sunday 21 April, we recommend doing so before 07:00.

Parking restrictions

Any vehicles parked on the route will be removed from 05:00 on Sunday 21 Aprl.

Please assist us by moving your vehicle off the route on the evening of Saturday 20 April. If your vehicle is relocated by event contractors, please visit **trace.london** to find it.

Vehicle Crossing Point

Drivers will be able to cross the route at a Vehicle Crossing Point on Creek Road before 08:50. The crossing point will then close to allow TCS London Marathon participants to pass. We anticipate it will reopen at 14:15.
