

Residents' Information:

Isle of Dogs



The 44th annual edition of the London Marathon takes place on Sunday 21 April 2024 and will require road closures and parking restrictions in your area.

Tens of thousands of participants will take on the 26.2-mile course, which starts in Greenwich, crosses Tower Bridge and travels through the Isle of Dogs before finishing on The Mall in Westminster

This leaflet provides specific access details for Isle of Dogs residents.

Restricted access

So the 2024 TCS London Marathon can go ahead safely, vehicle access to and from the Isle of Dogs will be restricted from 09:00 to 16:30 on Sunday 21 April.

To enter

If you need to drive onto the Isle of Dogs between 08:00 and 19:00 on Sunday 21 April, please use the A13 East India Dock Road, Leamouth Road to Leamouth Roundabout, and take Blackwall Way to access Prestons Road.

Please note: the existing bus-only section of Blackwall Way will be suspended from 08:00 to 19:00 on Sunday 21 April to allow access to the Isle of Dogs.

To exit

If you need to drive off of the Isle of Dogs between 09:00 and 16:30 on Sunday 21 April, please use Prestons Road and Cotton Street Roundabout to access Aspen Way eastbound towards Canning Town.

Parking restrictions

Any vehicles parked on the route will be removed from 05:00 on Sunday 21 April. Please assist us by moving your vehicle off the route on the evening of Saturday 20 April. If your vehicle is relocated by event contractors, please visit **trace.london** to find it.
