

MALDON ON SATURDAY 25 MAY 2024

Access to Maldon from Heybridge

Before 12:00 and after 15:30 access to central Maldon, including Butt Lane and High Street East car parks, is via A414 Maldon Bypass, Limebrook Way and Mundon Road.

Access to White Horse Lane car park is via Fambridge Road. To access Promenade Park use A414 Maldon Bypass and Limebrook Way.

Between 12:00 and 15:30, the A414 Maldon Bypass is closed for each passage of the race. Please use the alternative route via Great Totham, Tiptree, Kelvedon, A12, A414 (via Danbury) and into the south side of Maldon. Please note: there will be a short temporary road closure in Tiptree at approximately 11:50.

There is no vehicle access from Heybridge to Tesco, Lidl and surrounding businesses between 12:00 and 15:30.

Access to Maldon from Dengie Peninsula

Access to central Maldon, including Butt Lane and High Street East car parks, is via Mundon Road.

Access to White Horse Lane car park via Fambridge Road is available throughout the day. Access to Promenade Park is via Limebrook Way and Park Drive as usual.

There is no direct access by vehicle to Heybridge via Maldon, including Tesco, Lidl and surrounding businesses between 12:00 and 15:30 as Maldon Bypass and Fullbridge are closed for each passage of the race.

Access to Maldon from Chelmsford

Access to central Maldon, including Butt Lane and High Street East car parks, is via A414 through Danbury, then via Limebrook Way and Mundon Road.

Access to White Horse Lane car park via Fambridge Road is available throughout the day. Access to Promenade Park is via Limebrook Way and Park Drive as usual.

Access to Market Hill

Market Hill is closed from 04:00 to 20:00 except for local access. There is no access to Market Hill from the High Street from 04:00 to 20:00.

Local access to Market Hill is facilitated via Fullbridge for residents, care providers and deliveries between 04:00 and 10:30, 11:30 and 12:00 and 15:30 and 20:00.

Access to Maldon High Street

Pedestrian access is available at all times and businesses are open as usual. There is no vehicle access to the upper High Street (West Square to Wantz Road junction) between 04:00 and 20:00.

Lower High Street (Wantz Road junction to Mill Road and Promenade Park) is open to vehicles as normal except for a 30-minute temporary road closure from 10:45 to 11:15.

Spital Road and St Peter's Hospital

Access to the hospital is via Fambridge Road. Spital Road will be closed from 14:00 to 15:30, emergency access to St Peter's Hospital will be maintained at all times.

Maldon town centre car parks

High Street East is open and accessed via Mundon Road and Wantz Road except for a 30-minute temporary road closure between 10:45 to 11:15.

Butt Lane is open and accessed via Mundon Road and Wantz Road except for a 30-minute temporary road closure between 10:45 to 11:15.

White Horse Lane and Friary Fields car parks are open and accessed via Limebrook Way and Fambridge Road all day.

The Causeway and Blackwater Retail Park

There will be a short temporary road closure of The Causeway between 10:30 and 11:30. The Causeway will then reopen for local access from Heybridge for the remainder of the day.

Fullbridge and local access

Between 04:00 and 20:00 there is no direct access to or from Maldon High Street via Fullbridge and Market Hill.

Local access to Market Hill is facilitated via Fullbridge for residents, care providers and deliveries between 04:00 and 10:30, 11:30 and 12:00, and 15:30 and 20:00.

Fullbridge will be fully closed between 12:00 and 15:30 with no vehicle access to Blackwater Retail Park and to nearby businesses including Tesco, McDonald's, Jewson and Lidl.

The riders will pass through Maldon town centre three times from London Road between 12:30 and 15:00, using the High Street and descending Market Hill for two laps before descending Spital Road and climbing Market Hill on the third and final lap for a thrilling finish on the High Street.
