



Ford RideLondon 2023 fact sheet

We're delighted the world's greatest festival of cycling is returning after a successful new-look edition in 2022 – and we're delighted to have you on board for the 100-mile event on Sunday 28 May.

Background

RideLondon was established by the Mayor of London in 2013 as an Olympic legacy event from the London 2012 Games. In addition to the 100-mile challenge, 2023 Ford RideLondon will feature shorter, family-oriented rides on traffic-free roads – stay tuned for further details over the coming months.

In 2022 RideLondon saw a brand new partnership with Essex County Council come to frutition and an exciting new three-day UCI Women's WorldTour race take place – this will also be back in 2023.

The immensely popular RideLondon FreeCycle will also return in 2023, with traffic-free, family-friendly routes in central London and festival sites.

In January 2023 we announced Ford as RideLondon's new title partner, in a three-year partnership that builds on the success of Ford's role as presenting partner in 2022.

The route

The route will start and finish in central London and will include a loop of the beautiful Essex countryside in between.

We will be ensuring the route is very accessible for riders with a wide range of cycling abilities – we want this to be the most inclusive RideLondon yet!

Key Ford RideLondon-Essex 100 info

- Welfare provision across the 100 miles
- Riders to have a minimum of nine hours to complete the ride
- Start times will be between 06:00 and 09:30 on the day
- All riders to complete the 100-mile ride by 18:30









While the first 10,000 general entry places for the Ford RideLondon-Essex 100 sold out within 32 hours, people still had a chance to gain a place by entering a ballot.

The ballot was free to enter and closed at 17:00 on Tuesday 1 November 2022. We announced the results on Tuesday 8 November and riders had until 1 December to confirm and pay for their place.
