Road closures will be in place in Greenwich from 06:00 to 16:00 on Sunday 1 September.

The information provided in this leaflet is supplementary to The Big Half Road Closure Information booklet.

Please make sure you have read the booklet, available at **thebighalf.co.uk/road-closures**

The Big Half is a one-day festival centred around a half marathon running event. The event route will enter Greenwich from Evelyn Street, pass through Creek Road and finish at Cutty Sark.

If you need access either north or south of Creek Road between 08:50 and 15:00, please move your vehicle to the side of the route you require before 08:50 on Sunday 1 September.

Road closures to the east of Greenwich will be in place from Blackwall Lane, but stewards will assist if you need to access your premises.

Creek Road will open as soon as it is safe to do so to allow access to Deptford Church Street and Evelyn Street. Greenwich Town Centre will remain closed to through traffic until 16:00.

Two Vehicle Crossing Points will allow drivers access across the event route on Sunday 1 September.

Vehicle Crossing Point 17

Creekside – Gonson Street and Glashier Street
Closed for participants from 08:55 to 15:15

Vehicle Crossing Point 18

Norman Road – Norway Street

Restricted access from 08:55 to 15:15



PARKING RESTRICTIONS

If you have a vehicle parked on the event route, please remove it on Saturday 31 August. All parking bays on the route will be suspended and vehicle removal will commence from 04:00 on Sunday 1 September.

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Welland Street

Due to the large number of residents in and around Welland Street, vehicle access will be permitted onto Creek Road. You will be directed to join Vehicle Crossing Point 18 at Norman Road – Norway Street via the Thames Tideway site until 08:55.

Pedestrian access is available to cross Creek Road. Some local parking bays will be suspended and vehicle removals will commence from 04:00 on Sunday 1 September.

Park Row (south)

Access to Park Row on Sunday 1 September is restricted, but stewards will facilitate access to this area if you arrive from the Trafalgar Road junction of Blackwall Lane.

Haddo Street and Roan Street

Haddo Street and Roan Street (west side) will be closed to traffic from 12:30 to 15:30 on Sunday 1 September. If you have a vehicle parked on the event route, please remove it on Saturday 31 August.

All parking bays on the route will be suspended and vehicle removal will commence from 04:00 on Sunday 1 September.

King William Walk (south)

Vehicle access will be facilitated throughout the day by stewards. Local businesses will operate as usual.

Greenwich town centre

Local businesses, Greenwich Market, and Greenwich foot tunnel will be open as usual.

The University of Greenwich will be open as usual and vehicles will be able to access the car parks on Park Row but only by approaching via Trafalgar Road.

Greenwich Visitor Centre, the Painted Hall and the University will be accessible on foot via signposted walking routes. Please allow additional time to walk to these areas.

Local bus services from Romney Road to Greenwich High Road will operate through the road closures. River boat services will operate as normal.
