RESIDENTS' INFORMATION SUNDAY 1 SEPTEMBER 2024

Road closures from 06:00 to 14:00 on Sunday 1 September

The information in this leaflet is supplementary to The Big Half Road Closure Information booklet. Please make sure you have read the booklet, available at thebighalf.co.uk/the-events/road-closures

Roads in Limehouse, Westferry and Canary Wharf will close at 06:00 and reopen at 14:00 on Sunday 1 September 2024. A vehicle crossing point will operate during the times stated and will close to traffic in advance of the participants.

The event will start by Ensign Street at the junction of The Highway, before travelling east along The Highway and through the Limehouse Link Tunnel, Aspen Way and into Canary Wharf.

Participants will then return via Westferry Road, Limehouse Causeway and Narrow Street where they will rejoin The Highway and continue through Wapping towards Tower Bridge.

Vehicle Crossing Point

Three Colt Street

Closed for participants from 08:25 to 12:05

The vehicle crossing point will be open from 06:00 to 08:25. It will then close to allow participants to pass and is anticipated to reopen at 12:05.

Access to Three Colt Street is available from Commercial Road throughout the day. Additionally, an exit route via Grenade Street to West India Dock Road north towards Commercial Road and Burdett Road is available during the road closure period.

Canary Wharf

Access is available to Canada Square car park from Preston's Road roundabout and Trafalgar Way from 06:00 to 08:00.

Isle of Dogs

Access and exit is available via Preston's Road. Westferry Road will be closed to traffic during the event but a southbound bus service will be operational.
